# NEC SV8100 (analogue phone) - Quick User Guide

# MAKING CALLS:

To make a call to another extension:

- Lift handset or press **Speaker** key (if available).
- Dial extension number (101,102 etc) or press Direct Station Key (if available).
- Wait for answer or talk if the receiving station is hands free.
- To toggle between voice and ringing on receiving phone dial "1".

To make an outside call:

- Lift handset or press Speaker key (if available).
- Dial "**0**"
- Dial telephone number.

To make an outside call using system speed dial

• Lift handset or press **Speaker** key (if available).

• Dial "\*"

• Dial speed dial location number (**000-899** for system **or 900-920** for personal) To make a call using Last Number Redial:

- Lift handset or press Speaker key (if available).
- Dial "#"

# ANSWERING CALLS:

To answer an outside call:

- If ringing at your handset Lift handset or press **Speaker** key.
- If not ringing at your handset Lift handset and dial "\*#".

## PLACING/RETREIVING A CALL ON HOLD

- Whilst on a call press **recall** button (may also be called "**flash**", "**hookflash**" or just "**R**")
- To retrieve call repeat above procedure

# TRANSFERRING CALLS:

- Press the recall button (may also be called "flash", "hookflash" or just "R")
- Dial the extension number (101,102 etc)
- Announce the call
- Hang up. The call will be transferred.

## DO NOT DISTURB (DND):

## To activate/deactivate

- Lift handset or press Speaker key (if available).
- Dial "747" followed by
- "1" for DND on incoming calls only
- "2" for DND on intercom calls only
- "3" for DND on both incoming and intercom
- "4" for DND on transferred (Call forwarded) calls
- "0" to cancel DND

## <u>PAGING:</u>

To page all extensions:

- Lift handset
- Dial "8011"
- Make announcement.

Press receiver down with hand then hang up.

#### CALLING DOOR STATIONS:

To call a door station:

- Lift handset"
- Dial "**7021**" for door 1 or "**7022**" for door 2.
- To open the door/gate, press recall key (may be called "flash", "hookflash" or "R")
