MAKING CALLS:

To make a call to another extension:

- Lift handset or press **Speaker** key.
- Dial extension number, (10,11,12 etc.) or press Direct Station Key if programmed.
- Wait for answer or talk if the receiving station is hands free.

NB: To toggle between voice and ringing dial "1".

To make an outside call:

- Lift handset or press **Speaker** key.
- Dial "0" or press "Line" key
- Dial telephone number.

To make an outside call using preview dialing:

- While handset is idle dial telephone number
- Press outside line key number will be called automatically.

To make an outside call using speed dial (see below to program speed dial):

- Press SPD key (Redial key on Axis/Master handsets)
- Dial speed dial location number (System **20-99**, Personal **00-19**)
- Lift handset or press Speaker key to dial.

To make a call using Last Number Redial:

- Lift handset or press **Speaker** key.
- Press Redial key (Redial # on Axis/Master handsets)

ANSWERING CALLS:

To answer an outside call:

- If ringing at your handset Lift handset or press **Speaker** key.
- If not ringing at your handset Lift handset and press the flashing "Line" key.

TRANSFERRING CALLS:

To transfer a call:

Method 1:

- Answer or make a call.
- Press the Hold key.
- Dial the extension number (10,11,12 etc) or press the Direct Station Key if programmed.
- Announce the call and the "line" number.
- Hang up.

Method 2: (This method must be used when transferring to a cordless phone).

- Answer or make a call as above.
- Press Transfer key.
- Dial the extension number (10,11,12 etc) or press the Direct Station Key if programmed.
- Announce the call.
- Hang up and the call will be transferred.

PAGING:

To page all extensions:

- Lift handset
- Dial " 70 " (for external only dial "75").
- Make announcement.
- Press receiver down with hand then hang up.

BACKGROUND MUSIC:

To turn background music on/off (where available):

- Press **Feature** key
- Dial " 93 ".
- Press Feature key again.

PROGRAMMING SPEED DIAL NUMBERS:

To program speed dial numbers (system and personal):

- Press Feature key.
- Press SPD key.
- Dial location number (20-99 for system numbers, 00-19 for personal numbers).
- Dial telephone number to be stored.
- Press Feature key (NB: System numbers can only be programmed from extensions 10 & 11).

PROGRAMMING "ONE TOUCH" KEYS

To program one touch keys to be a speed dial key:

- Press Feature key.
- Press SPD key (press Redial on Axis/Master handsets).
- Press key to be programmed (be sure the key is not already programmed as a Line).
- Dial " 0" (this makes the button a speed dial key). ^^
- Dial Speed dial LOCATION number (ie: 00 to 19)
- Press **Feature** key.

^^ NB: To program the key to be an external phone number (instead of a location) dial " * " followed by the external phone number.

To program one touch keys to be a Direct Station key:

- Press **Feature** key.
- Press SPD key (press Redial on Axis/Master handsets).
- Press key to be programmed (be sure the key is not already programmed as a Line).
- Dial "1" (this makes the button a station access key (ie somebody else's extension).
- Dial the extension number to be stored (ie: 10,11 etc).
- Press Feature key.

RECEPTION (EXTENSION 10) ONLY FEATURES

SET TIME AND DATE

To set time and date (at reception extension **10** only):

- Press Feature key.
- Dial "9" then "#".
- Enter hours and minutes using the dial pad.
- Adjust AM/PM using the Recall key.
- Press Hold key.
- Adjust day of the week using the Recall key.
- Press # to move curser to 'day' and enter correct day using dial pad.
- Press Recall key to select correct month.
- Press # to move curser to 'year' and enter correct year using dial pad.
- Press **Feature** key to end.
